## Palette:

Deco Art Americana  
Cool Neutral  
Titanium White  
Light French Blue  
Deep Midnight Blue

## Brushes:

Size 1 & 4 Round Brushes  
Size 10/0 Long Liner  
Base coating and Varnishing Brushes

## Other Supplies:

Chalk pencil  
Super Chacopaper  
Stylus  
Plus your usual painting supplies



Prepare the box as usual. Base coat the top of the lid with a mix of Cool Neutral + Titanium White 1:1. Base coat the band around the top of the lid and the sides of the lid and box with Light French Blue. Paint inside the box a colour of your choice.

Transfer the pattern to the lid preferably with Chacopaper.

Referring to the step-by-step illustrations and using a suitably sized round brush paint the first layer of all the flowers and the buds with Light French Blue. NOTE that a lot of this painting is done with comma strokes. Apply the shadows with the round brush (for the dots and commas) and the liner (for outlining the petals) using Deep Midnight Blue. Finally add highlight strokes and dots with Titanium White.

Using Light French Blue paint in the stems with the liner and the comma stroke leaves with the small round brush. Use the liner and Deep Midnight Blue to add shadow strokes to the stems and leaves.

With the Cool Neutral + Titanium White mix dot around the inside edge of the band on the top of the lid. Using the liner and Deep Midnight Blue paint a line around the bottom of the side of the lid. On the side of the box just below the lid use a chalk pencil to mark an even row of dots right around the box. Use the mix and the small round brush to paint pairs of commas with their tails coming to the dots. Then use a stylus and the mix to paint in the dots.

Varnish and enjoy.
