

## Tactical offense within the USA in an alien invasion

I've been thinking about this during my sleep this afternoon.

Here are some assumptions.

The alternative would be to declare martial law and use a strong military presence to evacuate any civilians to the nearest shelter defended by military personnel.

The most the navy could do is take advantage of ground based radar and have marines communicate targets along shorelines and in some cases within land, however this would prove as fruitful as launching air strikes using bombers.

Space superiority would end up being the main issue in the minds of top ranking Pentagon officials. Space superiority would mean high level intelligence gathering that which would provide assistance in any massive counter-attack launched, removing the navy's state of paralysis, GPS could be brought back on line, the USAF will have it's attack capabilities restored to maximum strength and so will ICBM guidance systems.

The biggest question would be how would the Pentagon achieve space supremacy over the alien menace?
