

God is Complete

- He does not need you
- He did not need to create you
- He created you for your benefit and not His
- He created you to have a personal relationship with Him now and in eternity in heaven (The base of the The Kingdom of God)
- You are special to God as He made you to relate with Him and did not need to do so

Satan destroyed the original relationship

- Satan persuaded man to reject God's authority over them
- God saw man could not restore the relationship
- He sent Jesus:
 - to teach you what God required of you,
 - demonstrate The Kingdom and die
 - to remove all barriers between God and mankind
- He made it possible for you to be a citizen of The Kingdom of God again.

Jesus restored the relationship

- The Holy Spirit is in you to evidence this relationship
- It is possible to have this personal relationship with God 24/7
- Salvation (entrance to the Kingdom of God) is a personal relationship with Jesus and The Father as led by The Holy Spirit
- God has done all that is necessary to restore this relationship with you
- You must decide to accept what He has done.

The Two Kingdoms

- Kingdom of Heaven
 - Ruled by Jesus
- Kingdom of Satan
 - Ruled by Satan
 - Jesus allows him to rule for a time

Only Satan's Kingdom is on earth

- No boundaries around it dividing it from God's Kingdom
- No Fence sitters (no fence to sit on. You belong to one kingdom or the other)
- The Kingdom of God on earth is in the followers of Jesus that do His work or are either resting or in training to do His work

The Two Deliverances

Salvation

- Removal from the kingdom of Satan to the Kingdom of God (done by The Father)
 - Salvation is by faith in who Jesus is and what He has done for you (Eph 2:8-9)
 - Salvation is a relationship with The Father and Jesus (Jn 17:3)

Deliverance

- Removal of what the kingdom of darkness did to you (deliverance and healing does this).

We are citizens of heaven living on earth

- Pilgrims, strangers and Travellers in a foreign land
 - You do not need to look for The Kingdom of Heaven
 - It is in you Jesus Said.
 - A pilgrim is one journeying to a holy destination (heaven)
 - Strangers to the world and its lifestyle
 - Travelling through this world of the enemy
- Represent your King Jesus
 - Ambassadors
 - Servants
 - Warriors for Him

Is your God too small

- God is ruler of the universe
- He keeps it going, including you
- He owns you and everything you see around you and provides all you need to live and serve Him
- He commands countless angels and demons
- He has power of life and death over you both here and in eternity
- He loves you as His child and does all He can to help you be like Him
- your perspective of who God is will determine what you believe he can do

Some Comments

God does not judge you on what you do not know but on what you do with what you know. It is your attitude to what He teaches you that is important.

God does not judge you on your actions but on your hearts reason for doing them

Love for Jesus and His things (such as other people) should be the motivation for all you do as well as ministry. If it does not flow from your love it is from your flesh.

The Five Steps

- **REDEDICATE:** Give the problem, event, circumstances or situation etc., to Jesus to be Lord of
- **REPENT/FORGIVE** your self and all who hurt you
- **REBUKE:** Cast out Satan in Jesus' Name
- **HEALING:** Command Healing and Restoration in Jesus' Name
- **HOLY SPIRIT:** Ask Holy Spirit to replace the demons that have left

Step 1 Give it to Jesus

Give the area concerned, weakness, circumstance, sin, emotion, attitude, traumatic event, consequences, shock, whatever The Holy Spirit tells you give etc. to Jesus to be Lord of.

What Jesus is Lord of Satan cannot touch without the permission of Jesus because Jesus protects it.

Step 2 Repent and forgive

- Forgive others and your self
- Repent of any sin, bitterness, root of bitterness, anger, other wrong emotions toward others or your self (including wrong emotions in you that are hidden from your knowledge, etc.
- Ask Jesus for help to do this if necessary or do it purely out of obedient faith.
- Unforgiveness and unrepentance stops deliverance.

Unforgiveness

Mat 6:14-15 For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you: But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

Unforgiveness can result in you losing your salvation if it is not repented of

Not wanting to be reconciled with someone who has caused an offence to you is a form of Unforgiveness

Offences against others

Mat 5:23-24 Therefore if thou bring thy gift to the altar, and there rememberest that thy brother hath ought against thee; Leave there thy gift before the altar, and go thy way; first be reconciled to thy brother, and then come and offer thy gift.

If you do not forgive others their offences against you God cannot accept anything you bring to Him until you are reconciled to your brother. God is a God of reconciliation and expects you also to be of a similar mind as Him **and try and reconcile** where possible.

Step 3 Cast out Satan

In Jesus' Name Cast Satan to the Abyss and tell him to stay there.

Praying against Satan does little to remove him as he does not have to go unless told too.

You must take up your delegated authority and cast Satan out to remove him

Step 4 Command Healing

Command Healing in Jesus' Name on all the damage that Satan did to you.

Disease is demonic so proper healing of a disease requires the removal of the demon causing it as well as repentance of the sin that allowed the demon into you in the first place.

Step 5 Ask The Holy Spirit to replace the demons that have left your soul (house)

- Demons are cast out of the person's house which is the soul
- So when you cast a demon out you need to replace them in this house or seven more worse ones will enter the person at a later date
- Jesus told someone in a recent encounter with Him to replace them with The Holy Spirit
- The more of The Holy Spirit that fills the souls the less demons there are to influence the person and affect what they say and hear

Satan is a defeated enemy

- Jesus led him captive at calvary (Eph 4:8)
- You have delegated authority to control Satan for the purposes of Jesus and His Kingdom (in accordance with His Will and Purposes)
- You can prevent Satan attacking you or limit what he does to anyone if it promotes the purpose of Jesus and His Kingdom
- He is an escaped captive with no right to roam the earth or attack people so you can send him and his demons back to prison

Hearing The Holy Spirit

Rom 8:17 “For as many as are led by The Spirit of God. They are the sons of God”.

So how are you led by The Spirit of God?

How do you hear Him?

How does The Holy Spirit communicate

Unless Satan or The Holy Spirit appear to you personally the only way they can contact you is using your mind.

They will place in your mind something to communicate what they desire to tell you:

A picture, a thought, an emotion, attitude, or may even speak to you in your mind

Check the source of the communication

If the communication is From Satan it will cause fear and/or confusion and may not line up with what The Bible Says.

Remember, Satan uses the Bible when it suits him to use truth to mislead or sidetrack you

If it is from The Holy Spirit you will have peace. You may not like it but you will have peace about what you are told

It will line up with The Bible and help you do God's Will

Defeating Satan

Satan can only persuade you to sin if you accept what he suggests that you do.

If you do not accept it you do not sin

To defeat Satan reject what he places in your mind and then command him to go to the abyss in Jesus' Name and to stay there.

Why do you sin?

You accept the suggestions of Satan for a few reasons:

- You like the pleasure the sin gives you
- You do not realise the suggestion is from Satan and not your own mind
- You do not know how to deal with the temptation
- You believe the lie he tells you that you cannot defeat the temptation.
- You cannot see the way of escape God has given you
- You see no purpose in trying to fight Satan (low self-esteem)

How to handle temptation

Resisting Satan does not remove the demon so that temptations will continue

- You need to cast the demon to the abyss the moment they attack
- You need to reject what the demon suggests you do
- You need to find the way out God has given you
- If deliverance is needed because the demon is internal use the five steps
- If deliverance is not needed (the demon is external) cast the demon to the abyss asking The Holy Spirit to take its place (Last three steps).

Strategy for the Mind

Do not accept the thought from the demon so it does not enter your mind but cast it to the abyss immediately it attacks you

Do not react or assume anything but ask The Holy Spirit what to do. This stops demons using these reactions or assumptions against you as reactions and assumptions are too easily influenced by demons unless these are disciplined by the will

Decide not to accept what Satan places on you and command your mind to obey the Will of Jesus.

Satan is a defeated enemy

The Armour of a Christian only has protection in front. You are always to be either:

- Advancing,
- Holding ground,
- Learning how to fight or
- Resting from the battle.

You cannot turn your back on the enemy or you will go backwards spiritually so always attack Satan to defend and hold what you have taken from him.

Matthew 6:33

31 Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed?

32 (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek:) for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things.

33 But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousnesses; and all these things shall be added unto you.

34 Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof.

Matt 6:33 plain English

Do not worry about what you need to live

God knows what you need to live and serve Him

Seek Him and His purposes and all you need to do these will be provided by Him

Do not worry about tomorrow as you have enough problems to deal with each day.

The Principle in Mat 6:33

As you seek the:

- Purposes of The Kingdom of God (God's Will for you as a result of your place in The Kingdom)
- And the furthering (developing) of the relationship you have with Jesus and The Father

All you need to live in the way God require you to live will be provided by Him

All the promises made by God to you will be fulfilled and you will be matured by God into the image of Jesus

How do you keep Mat 6:33

Obedience to God in the things He asks you to do each day will ensure you observe the requirements of Mat 6:33

This is how you 'work out your salvation'.

As you focus on your relationship with Jesus and the purposes of His Kingdom in all you do you keep the attitudes necessary for salvation (Rom 12:1-3, Col 3:1-3).

Matt 6:33

God has prepared your life path from before creation, before you were born, for you to walk in and develop in the way He desires you to mature and develop.

As you walk in the principles of Mat 6:33 you walk this path and all God has for you and desires for you is on this path.

All that God has promised for you or prophesied to you will be on this Mat 6:33 path

Can you lose your salvation?

*Rev 3:5 He that overcometh, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and **I will not blot out his name out of the book of life**, but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels.”*

The people in Sardis were in danger of losing their salvation through continued disobedience to Jesus (v3). Their name would be blotted out of The Lamb's Book of Life if they did not obey.

They had salvation otherwise they would not have been in Lamb's Book of Life.

On Faith

Either God is or He is not. If He is you better do what He says. If He is not then you do what you want as you are accountable to no one.

If you believe God exists you better find out what he wants from you

The Bible and The Holy Spirit tell you what God wants you to do so you better bet to know your Bible and to be able to hear The Holy Spirit clearly

Signs that follow believers

Jesus said certain signs would follow believers as they did His work:

*In my name shall they cast out devils;
They shall speak with new tongues;
They shall take up serpents;
and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them;
they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.*

If these signs are not a part of your life you had better find out why!

Rewards are Certain

- Gal 6:7-8 We will be rewarded after we died according to how we obeyed Jesus
 - If we served Satan (even if only by lukewarmness) we will share in His rewards (Hell)
 - If we served Jesus we will have a mansion and share in rewards in heaven (Heb 11:6 we must believe it is worth serving Jesus).
- You must endure to the end to receive the rewards He has for you (1 Cor. 15:58, Gal 6:8-9)

You choose your eternal destiny

- God offers you choices:
 - Serve Him or by not obeying Him
 - Serve Satan
- He will never ask you to do more than you can do (1 Cor. 10:13)
- He will help you in your Christian walk and has prepared the path for you to follow
- According to the desire you have for eternal rewards or rewards on earth will be your eternal destiny as that is what your heart will follow.
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Life is Choices

Salvation is a result of correct choices made in accordance with the Guidelines of God (The Bible) and the guidance of The Holy Spirit

To not make these correct choices will cause difficulty and hardship

To have an indifferent (lukewarm relationship to Jesus will result in eternal death i hell

To reject Jesus as Lord will results in eternal death in hell

These are the only real choices you have. Obey God or Go to hell.
