1. ANNOUNCEMENT:

The Albury/Wodonga Motorcycle Club Inc., hereafter called the PROMOTER will conduct the 2008 Victorian Senior/Junior Dirt Track Titles at the Albury/Wodonga Lincoln Causeway Complex, on Sunday June 29th 2008.

2. JURISDICTION:

2.1. The abovementioned meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling Victoria which has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number [INSERT PERMIT NUMBER] and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia Senior National and Junior National Licences.

2.2. The meeting will be held in accordance with the current General Competition Rules (GCR's), these Supplementary Regulations, and any final instructions approved by Motorcycling Victoria.

BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS.

3. ENTRIES:

3.1. Entries open forthwith and close last mail Monday June 23rd 2008.

3.2. In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the Albury/Wodonga Motorcycle Club Inc., if such retention is approved by Motorcycling Victoria.

3.3. Only entries received on the official entry form that is accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted.

3.4. **NOTE:- LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AND THE RETURN OF ENTRY FEES FOR ANY RIDER WITHDRAWING FROM THE MEETING IS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE ALBURY/WODONGA MOTORCYCLE CLUB INC.**

4. INSURANCE:

4.1. National Personal Accident Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.

4.2. Ambulance Insurance is compulsory for licensees.

4.3. **IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT COMPETITORS GIVE CONSIDERATION TO TAKING OUT WEEKLY BENEFITS INSURANCE.**

5. MEDICAL SERVICES:

A qualified paramedic will be available with the support of St. Johns Ambulance from the start of practise to the

finish of the last race.

6 ENTRY FEE:

- 6.1. Senior Solo - \$80, Junior Solo - \$60, Sidecars - \$90, Quads - \$70, Additional Classes – \$20.
- 6.2. Payment by cheque or money order only. **ANY FEES FOR DISHONOURED CHEQUES WILL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ENTRANT.**
- 6.3. Cheques and Money Orders are to be made payable to the Albury/Wodonga Motorcycle Club Inc
- 6.4. Please include a self addressed stamped envelope for confirmation of entry and the issuing of entry passes and any final instructions. **NO ENVELOPE - NO PASSES.**

7 ENTRY PASSES:

Junior, Senior and Quad Classes will receive 2 entry passes.

9 AWARDS AND PRIZEMONEY:

Trophies will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place getters in all Title classes.
Sashes will be awarded to support classes.

10 ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:

10.1. To constitute a class, the number of contestants entered and competing in each class shall be 6 for Junior and Senior solo classes and 4 for Quads and Sidecars

10.2. Should there be insufficient entries in any class of competition, the decision to run or cancel the class, or to combine events and re-distribute any awards and / or prizemoney, will be at the discretion of the Albury/Wodonga Motorcycle Club Inc., subject to Motorcycling Victoria approval.

11 RACE FORMAT:

11.1 Racing will be over three rounds where there is only one full grid and over three rounds, a re-percharge and a final where there is

more than a full grid.

11.2 Scoring as per GCR's. Results will remain 'Provisional' until ratified and confirmed by Motorcycling Victoria.

12 MACHINES AND RIDERS:

12.1. All machines entered must comply with the current GCRs for Dirt Track competition.

12.2. Multiple entry of the one machine in the same class of competition is not permitted.

12.3. Changing of the machine on which you entered is not permitted unless it suffered mechanical failure and it has been approved by the Steward

13 RIDING NUMBERS:

13.1. Wherever possible, competitors will be allocated their registered riding number or their preferred riding number. All others will be allocated numbers at the Albury/Wodonga Motorcycle Club Inc. discretion.

13.2. All number plates on all machines MUST comply with the GCRs.

14 GRID POSITIONS:

14.1 For all Heats, grid positions will be pre-drawn and printed in the program.

14.2 For all Finals, grid positions shall be chosen by the Competitor - in order of points scored, with the highest cumulatively scored Competitor having first selection.

15 RIDERS' BRIEFING:

A rider's briefing will be held prior to the commencement of racing, which ALL competitors MUST attend. Details will be included in the final instructions.

16 DRUG AND OR ALCOHOL TESTING:

16.1 All competitors and officials are advised that as part of the MA drug education program, drug testing may take place at any competition in accordance with Australian Sports Commission policy as implemented by the Australian Sports Drug Agency.

16.2 If any doubts exist over banned substances it is recommended competitors contact the Drugs in Sport Hotline, tel 1800 020 506. When drug testing takes place, the payment of prizemoney may be delayed at the Motorcycling Victoria discretion until the results of the tests are known.

17 CODE OF CONDUCT:

All competitors, officials and parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia by-law - CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the GCRs), which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all motorcycle race meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this Meeting and will be enforced.

For the purposes of drug and alcohol testing, the commencement of the meeting will be deemed to be 7:00am with the completion of the meeting for the participant being when the participant has vacated the venue.

19 CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION:

19.1 For all classes of competition the circuit is approximately 650 metres in length, clay based with granite surface, graded, rolled and watered.

20 STARTS:

20.1 All starts will be a clutch start from a concrete starting pad with self penalising drop gates.

20.2 The starting grid has provision for a maximum of fifteen (15) Solos and six (6) Quads at a time.

21 RACING:

21.1 All competitors shall be given one (1) Practice session of three (3) laps for each Class of Competition.

21.2 All Heats shall be conducted over four (4) laps.

21.3 All Finals shall be conducted over five (5) laps.

22. NOISE:

As per GCR's 20.3.1

23. GST:

The Goods and Services Tax affects the payment of prizemoney. If you do not provide an ABN or declare the sport is a hobby, the Promoter must withhold 48.5% of prizemoney over \$50.00 which is otherwise payable to you. Please tick one of the boxes on the entry form and if appropriate provide your ABN to ensure the full amount of prize money is paid to you.

24. SPECIAL NOTES AND WARNINGS:

- 24.1 Knobby rear tyres of any type or construction are not permitted under any circumstances on machines over 65cc.
- 24.2 Presentation will take place near the canteen area at the completion of racing.
- 24.3 Animals are not permitted in the confines of the complex during the conduct of the meeting unless being used by a person to alleviate a disability.
- 24.4 Thongs or open shoes, alcohol, pushbikes or scooters are NOT permitted in the pit area.
- 24.5 Machines are NOT to be ridden in the pit area or car park. Any competitor caught doing so may have points revoked and be excluded from the meeting.
- 24.6 Hot Showers are available at the complex for both males and females.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISKS, DANGERS AND OBLIGATIONS

2. I ACKNOWLEDGE that the sport of motorcycle racing is dangerous and that by engaging in the sport and participating in the race meeting I take and am exposed to certain risks and dangers and am under certain obligations as follows:

- a) that I may be injured, physically or mentally, and may be killed;
- b) that my machinery or equipment may be damaged, lost or destroyed;
- c) that other competitors may ride dangerously or with lack of skill;
- d) that track or event conditions may be hazardous and may vary without warning or predictability;
- e) that the organisers, officials, landowners/track operators and any agent or representatives of those in charge of race meetings are frequently obliged to make decisions under pressure of time and/or events;
- f) that any policy of insurance of or in respect of my life or physical or mental health may be avoided;
- g) that there may be no or inadequate facilities for treatment or transport of me if I am injured;
- h) that I have an obligation to myself and others to compete safely and within the rules of competition.

INDEMNITY GIVEN TO ORGANISERS

3. IN CONSIDERATION of the acceptance of me as an entrant in the meeting **I AGREE TO INDEMNIFY** the organisers and each of them in the following manner:

- a) that I participate in the race meeting at my sole risk and responsibly;
- b) that I accept the venue as it stands with all or any defect hidden or exposed;
- c) that I indemnify and hold harmless the organisers, their respective servants, agents or officials against any actions or claims which may be made by me or on my behalf or by other parties for or in respect of or rising out of my death or any injury, loss or damage caused to me or to my machine or equipment whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any manner whatsoever.
