- \* The Harley Club of Victoria was established in 1924 and has held competition events since its beginning. We are one of the oldest motorcycle clubs in Australia and were originally named after the Harley Davidson motorcycle. We ran beach racing, 2 day road trials, road racing, bitumen and dirt hill climbs, sports days, trials, hare and hounds, scrambles, dirt tracks, motocross, grass track, rallycross and many other types of events and still hold many of the above.

- \* Membership is open to children, adults and families with discounted membership to country members who live more than 50 klms from the Melbourne CBD.

- \* Our membership runs from July 1st to June 30th of the following year, (financial year).
- \* Country member fees are half the above annual fees and all fees are calculated on a pro rata basis from the month of joining
- \* A monthly newsletter is sent out approximately a week before the general meeting and our Annual General meeting is held on the 4th Tuesday in June.
- \* We hold General meetings on the 4th Tuesday of every month except in December, starting at 8pm.
- \* Our meeting place is at the Scout Hall at the end of Youth Road, Eltham, west of the railway station.
- \* We have been affiliated with Motorcycling Victoria (previously the ACUV) since its beginning in 1926 and all our events are run with Motorcycling Australia permits and insurance cover.
- \* All members who ride in our events must have a current MA competition license, recreation licence or use one event licences, be a financial member of an MA affiliated club and have Ambulance Victoria membership.
- \* Junior members can obtain either a National or Club licence for racing and practising, or a recreational licence for non competitive riding and practising, or buy a one event licence on the day of riding.
- \* Senior riders can obtain the same as above
- \* 2007 MA Competition licence costs are :

- \* Super Saturdays for practice on all tracks (except Dirt Track) is held on the last Saturday of the month, subject to availability and dirt track practice is normally on the 3rd Sunday of the month. Always ring before going to Broadford as dates/events may change and dirt track cannot be run after heavy rain.
- \* We also compete in other clubs events such as the Leongatha MCC hill climb, the Interclub Road Race Series, the Viper pre '80 MX series to sample just a few.
- \* We have a number of members who regularly trail ride including the annual 2 day AMTRA event at Abbeyard near Mt Buffalo and a 2 day ride to Bright on the Melbourne Cup weekend which has been going since 1992. We also have a number of road bike riders in the Club with bikes ages ranging from the 1920s up to present day.
- \* Our members ages are from 6 years old to over 80 and we have 11 life members
- \* We are registered with Vic roads for the Red plate scheme which allows bikes over 25 years old to be used in Club events on public roads. Cost to register these bikes is approx. \$100 annually.
- \* We run a Club championship competition for juniors and seniors through the year covering a number of different events and have Club Champion presentations for competition members some time in late November or early December
- \* We now own the property next door to the State Motorcycle Sports Complex.
